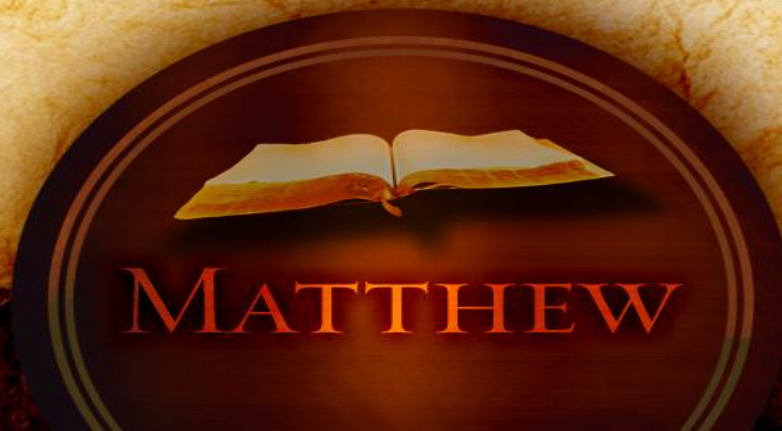

# Matthew 7:28

28 Now it happened that when Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were astonished at His teaching;

- Astonished: “To cause to be filled with amazement to the point of being overwhelmed.”
- Literally: “To be struck out of one's sense.”





Luke 2:46-48 “And it happened that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. And all who heard Him were astounded at His understanding and His answers.”





- ✓ Luke 4:32 “And they were amazed at His teaching, for His message was with authority.”
- ✓ Mark 1:22 “And they were astonished at His teaching; for He was teaching them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.”
- ✓ Mark 11:18 “And the chief priests and the scribes heard this, and began seeking how to destroy Him; for they were afraid of Him, for the whole crowd was astonished at His teaching.”





# John 7:32; 45-46

“The Pharisees heard the crowd whispering these things about Him, and the chief priests and the Pharisees sent officers to seize Him....The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, and they said to them, “Why did you not bring Him?” The officers answered, “Never has a man spoken like this!” The Pharisees then answered them, “Have you also been led astray?”

# Matthew Ch. 5



5:3 “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.”

5:17 “Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill.”

5:19 “Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.”

5:20 “For I say to you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.

5:21-43 “You have heard that it was said.....but **I** say to you” **6 times!**



# Matthew Ch. 6



6:6 “Your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you.

6:8 “Therefore, do not be like them; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.”

6:14-18 Look there.

6:29 “Yet I say to you that not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these.”



# Matthew Ch. 7



7:7 Who could say this but God?

7:13ff Jesus tells us who's getting into heaven and who is not.

7:21 People will stand before HIM?! (Jesus)

7:22 "Many will say to Me?" (!!!) What!?

7:23 Mind Bomb!

7:24-26 Hear My words! God's words! My words are God's words!!!
