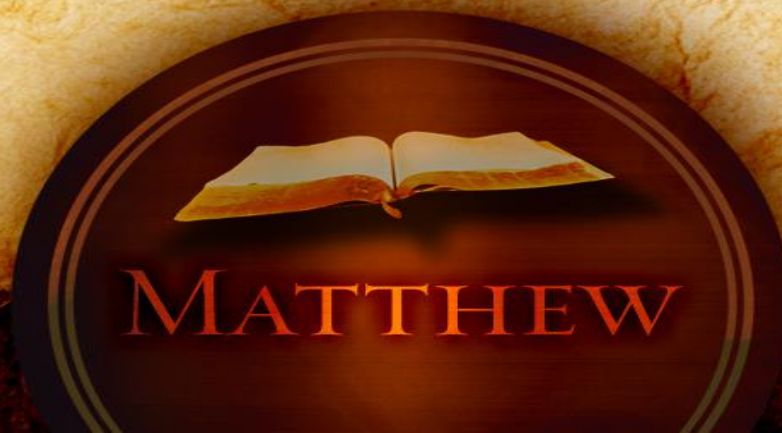




Matthew 8:14-17

Matt 20:34 “And moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him.”



The heart of Jesus

Luke 7:12-15 “Now as He approached the gate of the city, behold, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And a sizeable crowd from the city was with her. And when the Lord saw her, He felt compassion for her and said to her, “Do not cry.” And He came up and touched the coffin, and the bearers came to a halt. And He said, “Young man, I say to you, arise!” And the dead man sat up and began to speak. And Jesus gave him back to his mother.”
