




Matthew 8:23-27

Two points of the passage:

Ps 107:27-29 “They staggered and swayed like a drunken man, And all their wisdom was swallowed up. Then they cried to Yahweh in their trouble, And He brought them out of their distresses. He caused the storm to stand still, So that its waves were hushed.”
