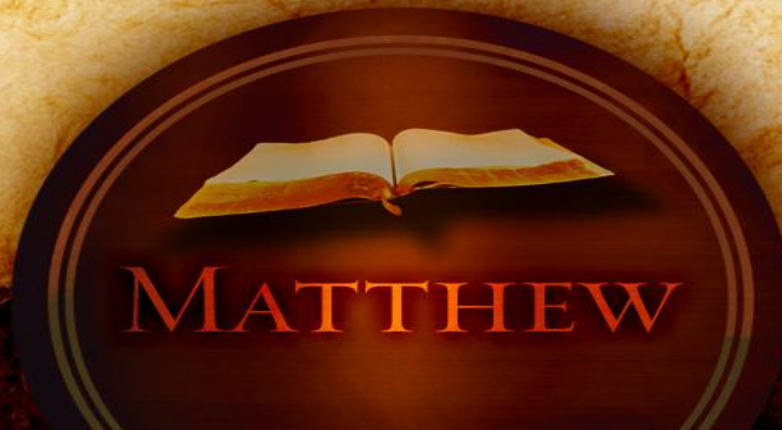

7 Things We Learn about Jesus

Part 1





7 Things We Learn About Jesus in this Text

- 1) He's meticulous/detailed/organized in how he does things. (vv. 5-15)
- 2) The Jewish people are important to Him. (vv. 5-6)
- 3) He wants His people to proclaim the gospel. (v. 7)
- 4) He doesn't want the gospel to become a means of great riches. (vv. 8-9)
- 5) He wants His people to trust the Lord for their provisions. (v. 9-10)
- 6) He wants His people to connect with the receptive/steer clear of the antagonistic. (v. 12-14)
- 7) He wants his people to know: Those that reject the gospel have severe judgment coming! (v. 15)



Matthew 10:5-15

These twelve Jesus sent out after instructing them, saying, “Do not go in the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter any city of the Samaritans; but rather go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. “And as you go, preach, saying, ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ “Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give. “Do not acquire gold, or silver, or copper for your money belts, or a bag for your journey, or even two tunics, or sandals, or a staff; for the worker is worthy of his support. “And whatever city or village you enter, inquire who is worthy in it, and stay there until you leave. “Now as you enter the house, give it your greeting. “And if the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. “And whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you leave that house or that city, shake the dust off your feet. “Truly I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city.



A. Who to go to:

1. Do NOT go to the Gentiles. (v. 5)
2. Do NOT go to Samaritans. (v. 5)
3. GO to “the lost sheep of the house of Israel” (v. 6)

B. What to say:

1. “The kingdom of Heaven is at hand” (v. 7)

C. What to do:

1. Heal, raise, cleans, cast out. (v. 8)
2. Do NOT take \$\$ for what you’re doing (v. 8b-9)
3. Do NOT take provisions (v. 10)

D. When you get there:

1. Inquire who is worthy/stay there (v. 11)
 - ❖ Bless that house/Greet (v. 12)
 - ❖ If worthy—let peace come upon it. (v. 13)
 - ❖ If not worthy—let your peace return to you. (v. 13)
2. Whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words.
 - ❖ As you Leave that house/city (v. 14)
 - ❖ Shake the dust off your feet (v. 14)
 - ❖ Judgment will be upon it (v. 15)



Isaiah 46:9-11

“Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, ‘My counsel will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure’, Calling a bird of prey from the east, The man of My counsel from a far country. Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass. I have formed it, surely I will do it.”



Psalm 139:1-6, 16

O Yahweh, You have searched me and known me. You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. You scrutinize my path and my lying down, And are intimately acquainted with all my ways. Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Yahweh, You know it all. You have enclosed me behind and before, And You have put Your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot attain to it....(16) Your eyes have seen my unshaped substance; And in Your book all of them were written the days that were formed for me, When as yet there was not one of them."

“And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose. Because those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brothers; and those whom He predestined, He also called; and those whom He called, He also justified; and those whom He justified, He also glorified.”
